

Pat Lust



Pat Lust, a native of Ohio farm country, holds multiple degrees in music and spent 37 years at Longwood University on the music faculty and in administration before retiring in 2016. In 2001, Ms. Lust joined the Heart of Virginia Master Gardeners and pursued her special interests in native plants and plant propagation.

In 2018, Ms. Lust moved to the Goochland/Powhatan Master Gardeners and has just completed a 4-year term as the Vice-President for Education. Under her leadership and active participation, GPMGA developed a speakers' bureau on a wide range of horticultural topics and a popular community-oriented course entitled Gardening 101.

Bryce Lane developed a passion for plants at an early age in Massachusetts and earned advanced degrees in Plant Science and Ornamental Horticulture. He served on the faculty of NC State University from 1981 to 2014, teaching and advising more than 25,000 students. He was the recipient of numerous local, regional, and national teaching awards.

From 2003-2014 Bryce hosted the UNC TV program, *In the Garden with Bryce Lane*. His retirement time is spent giving horticultural talks, working with the NC State Extension and NC Nursery and Landscape Association, and teaching part-time. An avid gardener, Bryce has gardened on the same one-quarter acre plot for 40 years.

Mary Ann Hansen is a retired Extension Plant Pathologist with advanced degrees in her field. She served on the faculty of Virginia Tech from 1984–2022, leading the Plant Disease Clinic and teaching plant diagnostics, domestication, and general biology. Ms. Hansen is also a founding member of the Virginia Boxwood Blight Task Force, a definitive source of information on this invasive fungal disease.

Mary Ann has also enjoyed teaching Master Gardeners over the course of her 37-year career, including leading memorable labs in Plant Pathology for the Danville Master Gardener classes. In retirement, she still spends time looking through the barrel of a microscope and taking pictures of colorful fungi!
